- **Dean's updates:** Students are requesting on-campus housing; Landmark will have a shortened season, so a few more students may sign up to be on campus. We are allowing students to choose singles or to have a roommate. Roughly 20% of the classes are in-person only. DVT lessons learned from SLACs suggest that isolation is the worst part.
- **Concerns about Ladder** BS degrees do not show up in Ladder for anyone who wishes to declare a major. They must contact the department chair to be added!
  - 1. The minutes of the 11-04-20 meeting were approved
  - 2. Sabbatical applications update
    - a. Sabbaticals folder (see the eligibility document)
    - b. The Deans pre-viewed the applications and DC discussed several of the complexities that might result and the value of having a policy to clarify the relationship between appointed positions and sabbaticals.
  - 3. Elected committee elections
    - a. Faculty Survey Initial slate of candidates from Div I and II were discussed.
    - b. Committee Slate 2021-2022 working version
  - 4. Dean's Council discussed the draft description of the Pan-African Studies position.
  - 5. Discussion about line requests we are in essence in a hiring freeze, but there are a few searches underway. Chemistry and MCOM were reauthorized in the summer; accounting (a failed search last year) and Data Analytics (an August resignation) are both underway. PanAf is about to run.
  - 6. Discussion about NTT to TT line conversions we have been authorized to begin the process of converting a few lines from NTT to TT and to develop a process and criteria for the process.
  - 7. Faculty Handbook revisions tabled. It is not reasonable to expect to have anything for the December faculty meeting. Maybe we can dedicate a few hours in January or after classes end in December and just finish it?
