Minutes - Dean's Council March 28, 2018

1. Dean's Updates and Approval of Minutes

In midst of hiring Director of Graduate Admissions.

Diversity Office Search: Inviting candidates to campus.

Offers to new faculty underway.

Lots to accomplish with Dean's Council - meetings will be streamlined

Some pieces- like the existence of a Center - will move forward, but other components are presented for discussion, such as how that happens and what components will look like, such as gen ed, which must be voted on by the faculty.

Nevertheless also time pressure for some type of reform, to make us distinctive in the market.

Note that items not in CRUE platform not eliminated (for example, will still prepare students for graduate school -- document focuses on new plans/processes/programs)

Many different iterations of gen ed discussed -- this presents one version to start discussion

Members of CRUE will come to division meetings; feedback will come back through Division reps on Dean's Council as well as through the CRUE members at those meetings; faculty will have the opportunity to offer feedback directly via the CRUE

website. Meetings with other faculty and staff/groups of faculty and staff can certainly happen as needed and requested.

Discussion of size of administration and cost of administration. Financial data will be discussed by the president in next faculty meeting.

Special faculty meeting will be scheduled to talk about CRUE, where there will be some summary given re. the feedback received from various conversations and meetings, and to continue the conversation.

Discussion of impact on small departments.
