

On the Ministry

1. The basic distinction is between the *constitutive* and the *constituted* ministry—or between the ministry constitutive *of* the church and the ministry constituted *by* the church.

2. The second, constituted ministry, or ministry constituted by the church, is also appropriately called the *representative* ministry.

3. Consequently, there is the further distinction between the *constitutive* and the *representative* ministry.
