What is the Enlightenment?

- (1) It is concerned with action, praxis, life, including social and cultural structures or institutions appropriate to authentic human life.
- (2) It holds that, precisely for the sake of action, praxis, life, human reason has a unique authority over all other putative authorities.
- (3) Consequently, no claim to validity is valid simply because someone makes or implies it. It is valid, if it is valid, only because it can be validated, finally, by reason and experience.
